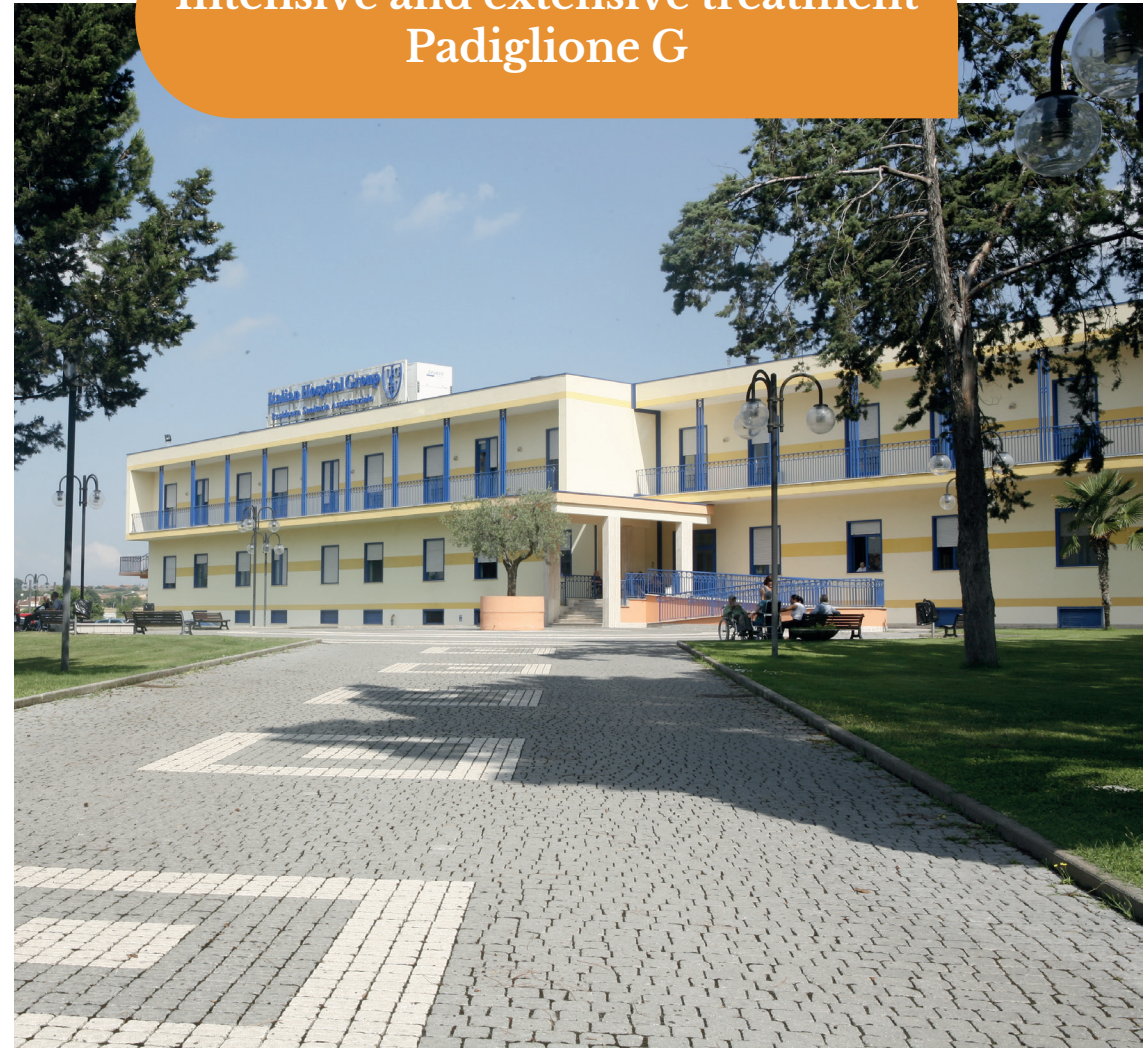

Residential Territorial Care Facilities for Non-Self-Sufficient People, Including the Elderly

Intensive and extensive treatment Padiglione G



INTENSIVE TREATMENTS

Bed Capacity: 20 under agreement with S.S.R.

They are intended for non-self-sufficient people, including elderly people, who are severely compromised and require support for vital functions (assisted mechanical ventilation, prolonged enteral-parenteral nutrition, treatment of vegetative states or prolonged coma, progressive neurodegenerative diseases, etc.).

EXTENSIVE TREATMENTS

Bed Capacity: 20 places of which 17 in agreement with S.S.R.

They are intended for non-self-sufficient individuals, including the elderly, with a need for high-level healthcare: medical care, daily nursing care, functional recovery treatments, administration of intravenous therapies, treatment of deep pressure ulcers, and other treatments that cannot be provided by home care.

ACCESS PROCEDURE

The request for recovery pathways is processed directly by the User or his family/legal representative to the Multidisciplinary Evaluation Unit (UVM) of the district of residence of the applicant, after completing the appropriate form.

Additionally, the request may also be made by:

- General practitioner;
- Specialist doctor;
- Other recovery facilities.

After evaluation by the competent UVM, in the presence of a favorable outcome, the process of admission to the facility will be initiated and, subject to availability of a place, the User will be contacted to arrange admission. At the time of discharge, clinical documentation will be provided to the attending physician. After discharge, the Guest or their caregiver/family/legal representative may request a copy of the clinical record from the Reception Office.

RECEPTION

The admission of guests must be coordinated with the reception office of the Pavilion. At the time of admission, the Guest must present to the Reception Office the following administrative documentation:

- Authorization for admission issued by the competent ASL (Local Health Authority);
- Personal identification document;
- Health insurance card;
- Health booklet and any exemption tickets;
- Any disability certificate;
- The name of the caregiver/family member/legal representative who will assume the role of privileged interlocutor in administrative matters as well as clinical-health aspects.

Additionally, the following documentation should be presented/delivered to the department:

- Medical report from the attending physician and/or discharge letter from another healthcare facility;
- Examination reports, clinical records, and general health documentation including therapeutic plans in progress;
- Pharmacological therapies currently being administered for continuity of care;
- Personal aids or those provided by the assigned ASL.

At the time of admission, the Guest will receive the Admission Card, which, together with the IHC Services Card, has contractual value.

PROJECT DURATION AND RENEWAL INTENSIVE AND EXTENSIVE TREATMENT

For this type of treatment, the project has an average duration of 60 days. Before the deadline, the Multidisciplinary Evaluation Unit (UVM) of the Regional Health Authority (ASL) will conduct an evaluation visit, following which the hospital stay can be extended or, if necessary, a transfer to another facility may be indicated.
